Our CMS colleagues shared some Medicare beneficiaries (less than 30,000) will be contacted as part of an ongoing study called the <u>Medicare Current Beneficiary Survey</u> (MCBS). CMS contracts with the University of Chicago, a respected social science research organization, to conduct the study known as the nonpartisan and objective research organization (NORC).

NORC will contact beneficiaries in coming weeks on the behalf of CMS. This is an <u>exception to typical guidance</u> that CMS will not contact Medicare beneficiaries directly. **Please help beneficiaries wishing to verify the study and interviewer by:**
